We had a profit of \$1,228.45 from the Cougar Cave in the past month. We are thinking of a 55/45 split for all fundraisers. We made \$108 off of the shirt fundraiser. It was proposed to do a t-shirt and polo fundraiser sale in February.

Old Business: Volunteers - posting on Facebook did help us secure a few more volunteers. Getting people to volunteer still remains a problem. Jon suggested charging higher fees for those that don't volunteer. Both golf carts need their tires replaced for next year. I'm not sure the exact amount of sales that my 6, 7,8 graders have but it has to be close to 80 or 90 percent of the money we make is from the EMS kids.
